3	What is the distance from the village sign to the telephone box? (clue - a large pace should equal 1 metre)	
4	How many windows are there in the telephone box?	
5	From the telephone box you can see a bridge - what direction does the water flow under the bridge - North to South, East to West, West to East or South to North?	
6	What date is on the Ufford Village sign and what does AD mean and what does the sign depict?	
7	The bridge and road barriers by the telephone box have lots of white posts – how many are there?	
8	How many houses or bungalows are there in The Avenue and what are their names?	
9	What flag is flying at Mead Lodge in School Lane and what animal is in the front garden of this house?	
10	How many chimneys are there on the Almshouses in Church Lane	
11	Where is there a dragon on the church porch?	
12	In the stained-glass window above the altar in the Church what are the First World War Soldier and Sailor doing?	
13	To whom were these Gates given in memory of in 1994?	
14	What is on the roof of St Mary's Hall

2	Two kinds of seeds	
3	A feather (an extra point if you can name the bird that it has come from)	
4	A stone with a hole in it	
5	A rabbit's egg	
6	3 different leaves – a clover leaf, a holly leaf and an ivy leaf	
7	A hazel nutshell (an extra point if you can find one that's been chewed open by a squirrel!)	
8	A pine cone
